Official information request for Statistical information relating to OIAs

I refer to your official information request dated 10 September for official information statistics for period 1 January – 30 June 2021.

The information you have requested is enclosed.

The Mental Health and Wellbeing Commission came into effect on the 9 February 2021. All responses are from 9th of February to the 30 June 2021 inclusively. You asked six questions about OIA response timeframes. They are listed below as you have requested.

Question	Response
1) From 1 January to 30 June 2021, how many OIA requests did your agency receive? (9 February 2021)	1
2) From 1 January to 30 June 2021, what was the average OIA response time, in working days (including any extension time) (9 February 2021)	16
3) From 1 January to 30 June 2021, what was the longest OIA response time, in working days (including any extension time) (9 February 2021)	16
4) From 1 January to 30 June 2021, what percentage of OIAs required a time extension (9 February 2021)	0
5) From 1 January to 30 June 2021, what percentage of OIAs were refused? (9 February 2021)	0
6) From 1 January to 30 June 2021, what percentage of OIAs were partially refused or redacted? (9 February 2021)	0
